Issued by the Mayor

Key Club Week November 4 – 10, 2001

WHEREAS, Key Club International, the largest high school service organization, sponsored by Kiwanis International, is observing the first full week in November as Key Club Week; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Key Club of the City of Sacramento are part of an international organization of over 215,000 students dedicated to serve with purpose their homes, schools, and communities, seeking to give primacy to the human and spiritual rather than the material values of life; and

WHEREAS, they promote the adoption of higher standards in scholastics, sportsmanship, and social contacts and the development of a more concerned citizenship; and
