SUBJECT: Howe Avenue/Power Inn Road Interconnect System and
Improvements (PN:SB01/SB66/SB71) - Contract Completion

SUMMARY

The work on the Howe Avenue/Power Inn Road interconnect system and improvements project was completed on June 29, 1989 at a cost of \$316,434.45 and project acceptance is recommended.

BACKGROUND

M & M Electric Company of Sacramento has completed Project No. SB01/SB66/SB71, Council Contract No. CO88021, dated October 5, 1988. This project provided for a traffic signal coordination system along Howe Avenue from Fair Oaks Boulevard to U.S. 50, along Power Inn Road from U.S. 50 to 14th Avenue and along Fruitridge Road from Wallace Avenue/Lowell Street to Power Inn Road. This project also upgraded the traffic signal systems at the intersections of Howe Avenue at American River Drive and Fruitridge Road at Wallace Avenue/Lowell Street. In addition, a new traffic signal system was installed at the intersection of Folsom Boulevard at East Bicentennial Circle. Minor modifications will be made at various locations within the traffic signal interconnect system.

FINANCIAL DATA

As of August 30, 1989 this project had a balance of \$1,599 in the Major Street Construction Fund (209), which is sufficient to close this contract.

The State of California participated in the cost of the traffic signal work done at Folsom Boulevard and East Bicentennial Circle in the amount

It is recommended that the City Council:


