SUBJECT: Abandonment of a Portion of 25th Street Between 47th and 48th Avenues and Alley between Woodbine Avenue and 24th Street - Summary AP No. 90-1

#### **SUMMARY**

The Department of Public Works requests that the City Council adopt a resolution abandoning a portion of 25th Street between 47th and 48th Avenues and the alley between Woodbine Avenue and 24th Street.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Mr. Hari Narayan is requesting an abandonment of a portion of 25th Street lying between the south line of 47th Avenue and the north line of 48th Avenue together with a 20-foot alley lying between the east line of 25th Street and the west line of Woodbine Avenue. The intent of the abandonment is to enlarge side and back yards and make the unimproved alley inaccessible to undesirable elements.

The proposed abandonment, exempt from the City's "Review Guidelines for Street Closures," was reviewed by staff and found to be in conformance with State law. Approval of the request is recommended. The Environmental Coordinator filed a Notice of Exemption for this project. Staff and the utility companies have reviewed the proposed abandonment and have no objections.

### **FINANCIAL DATA**

No expense to the City or to property owners is necessary for the proposed abandonment.

### **POLICY CONSIDERATIONS**

None.

#### **VOTE OF COMMISSION**

The proposed abandonment is exempt from review under Section 65402 of the California Government Code.

SUMMARY VACATION AND ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION OF 25TH STREET BETWEEN 47TH AND 48TH AVENUES AND ALLEY BETWEEN WOODBINE AVENUE AND 24TH STREET

#### ABANDONMENT PROCEEDING NO. AP90-1

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 8300, et. seq., of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, the City Council hereby vacates and abandons a portion of the following described easement:

All that certain real property situated in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California described as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 97 as shown on the "Plat of Cordova Tonwsite, filed in the office of the Recorder of Sacramento County on May 14, 1907, in Book 8 of Maps, Map No. 28; thence, in an easterly direction along the south right-of-way line of the east-west alley as shown on the Plat heretofore described 547 feet to the northeast corner of Lot 105; thence, south along the west right-of-way of 25th Street (formerly Larkspur Avenue), 170 feet to the southeast corner of said Lot 105; thence, east along the north right-of-way line of 48th Avenue (formerly Olive Avenue) to the southwest corner of Lot 106; thence, north along the east right-of-way line of 25th Street 170 feet to the northwest corner of said Lot 106; thence, east along the south right-of-way line of said east-west alley 540 feet to the northeast corner of Lot 114; thence, north along the west right-of-way line of Woodbine Avenue 20 feet to the southeast corner of Lot 79; thence, west along the north right-of-way line of said east-west alley 540 feet to the southwest corner of Lot 87; thence, north along the east right-of-way line of 25th Avenue 170 feet to the northwest corner od said Lot 87; thence, west along the south right-of-way line of 47th Avenue 60 feet to the northeast corner of Lot 88; thence, south along the west right-of-way line of 25th Street 170 feet to the southeast corner of said Lot 88; thence, west along the north right-of-way line of said east-west alley 547 feet to the southwest corner of Lot 96; thence, south along the east right-of-way line of 24th Street 20 feet to the point of beginning. RESERVING HOWEVER, for the above described real property for the right-of-entry to repair, maintain and construct sewer, water and gas pipes and aerial or underground power, telephone and other communication facilities now in place or which from time to time may be placed therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City Council does hereby find and declare that all of the facts, as set forth in this resolution, are true and correct; that by reason of the findings and premises aforesaid, said easements, as above set forth and described, is hereby declared abandoned and vacated.
