ORDINANCE NO. 589, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE NO. 579, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED MAY 4, 1933, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE LICENSING OF RETAILERS OF BEVERAGES AND THE SALE OF BEVERAGES; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 579, Fourth Series, passed May 4, 1933, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 5. No "On Sale" license hereunder shall be granted to the proprietor of a grocery store unless the beverage business is conducted in a separate building or in a separate room with no connecting doors between said businesses.

No "On Sale" license hereunder shall be granted to a restaurant or public eating place unless same makes a satisfactory showing by affidavit or otherwise, as the Council may require, that it is a bona fide restaurant and/or public eating house.

For the purpose of this ordinance, a bona fide restaurant and/or public eating house is defined as a place which is prepared and equipped to serve a hot meal to its patrons.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to take effect immediately. The said emergency is set forth and declared to be as follows: The State of California has heretofore passed an Act regulating the sale of "beverage", and the City of Sacramento has heretofore passed an ordinance regulating the sale of "Beverages", which said Act and Ordinance took effect immediately; it is also necessary that this ordinance take effect immediately since same is passed in pursuance of said State Law.
