AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 62.03.210(g) AND 62.04.220(a)(4) OF TITLE 62 OF THE CITY CODE RELATING TO CONTRIBUTION LIMITS FOR THE PRIMARY AND GENERAL ELECTIONS OF 1996 FOR CITY ELECTIVE OFFICE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1.

Section 62.03.210(g) of Title 62 of the City Code is amended to read as follows:

62.03.210(g) **Off-election year** shall mean each of the three years during the term of a city elective office in which an election for that office is not held; provided that (i) if a candidate for city elective office receives a majority of votes cast in the primary election, the period from July 1st through December 31st shall be considered an off-election year for purposes of applicable contribution limitations; (ii) for purposes of a special election to fill a city elective office that became vacant in a year prior to the year of the election, that year shall not be considered an off-election year; and (iii) for purposes of a special election to fill a city elective office, the period from the first day of the month following the month in which a special election is held through December 31st shall be considered an off-election year for purposes of applicable contribution limitations.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, for purposes of the elections to be held in 1996, the off-election year of 1995 shall be considered to terminate on August 31, 1995, and the period from September 1, 1995 through December 31, 1995 shall be considered part of the 1996 election year for purposes of the applicable contribution limits. If a candidate for City elective office receives a majority of votes cast in the primary election to be held on March 26, 1996, the period from April 1st through December 31, 1996 shall be considered an off-election year for purposes of applicable contribution elections.

SECTION 2.

Section 62.04.220(a)(4) of Title 62 of the City Code is amended to read as follows:


62.04.220(a)(4) **Timing of contributions:** For purposes of this section, a contribution made and accepted on or before June 30th to a candidate for a city elective office in a regular election shall be deemed to be contributions for the primary election, and contributions made and accepted on or after July 1st to a candidate for a city elective office in a regular election shall be deemed to be contributions for the general election.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, for purposes of the elections for City elective office to be held in 1996, a contribution made and accepted on or before March 31, 1996 to a candidate for a City elective office in a regular election shall be deemed to be contributions for the primary election, and contributions made and accepted on or after April 1, 1996 to a candidate for City elective office in a regular election shall be deemed to be contributions for the general election.
