SUMMARY

The attached resolution would authorize the execution of a contract with the Area 4 Agency on Aging for an additional \$46,496 awarded to the Sacramento Elderly Nutrition Program for FY 1979-80.

BACKGROUND

The Sacramento Elderly Nutrition Program's operating funds for FY 1979-80 were insufficient to maintain services at contractual levels. After initial indications for additional nutrition project funding through the State Department of Aging to offset inflationary cost increases failed to materialize, the Area 4 Agency on Aging made available \$46,496 in Title III-Cl, Older Americans Act funds for the Sacramento Elderly Nutrition Program to guarantee continuation of services provided for the elderly through the end of FY 1979-80. The amount covers the earlier projected budget deficit for FY 79-80. Notification of the additional allocation was received on June 18, 1980.
