SUBJECT: Arcade Creek Bank Restoration (PN:WB26) - Bid Rejection

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received, but rejection of all bids and readvertising for bids is recommended because of discrepancies in the specifications.

BACKGROUND

Because of the severe storms during the winter of 1985/86, damage to the Arcade Creek bank protection material has occurred adjacent to bridge structures at Roseville Road, Del Paso Boulevard and the Light Rail facility near Hudson Way. This project would restore the bank protection at the damaged locations.

On March 3, 1987, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on March 31, 1987. The bids received were:

Thorcon, Inc.	\$26,496
Trinco, Inc.	45,515
Johnson Western Gunite Co.	93,508

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$42,000.

A discrepancy in the description of the locations of the restoration sites between the sealed proposal forms and special provision pages caused confusion for the contractors in determining their bids. Therefore, it is believed that all bids should be rejected and the project readvertised for bids with corrected specifications.

FINANCIAL

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$54,000. The current budget is \$56,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program with \$15,000 from Capital Grant Funds and \$41,000 from Drainage Contingency Funds.

RECOMMENDATION


It is recommended that the City Council reject all bids and authorize the City Clerk to readvertise the project for bids to be received on May 5, 1987.
