SUBJECT: Appeal of Constance L. Lum from the decision of the Chief of Police denying a Massage Technician Permit

SUMMARY

Attached is the appeal of Constance L. Lum from the decision of the Chief of Police, denying an application for a Massage Technician Permit; as required by Section 28.51(c) of the Sacramento City Code.

BACKGROUND

Under Sections 2.323 and 2.324 of the City Code, the Council may appoint a hearing examiner to hear the appeal if it finds that "the appeal may involve a lengthy factfinding process which would be more appropriately accommodated by a formal hearing before a hearing examiner."

FINANCIAL DATA

The estimated cost would be \$100.00 and would be available from the Chief of Police budget.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. If the Council should decide to appoint a hearing examiner, it is recommended that the following motion be adopted: "The Council hereby determines pursuant to Section 2.324, City




Dear Miss Lum:

Pursuant to Section 28.50 of the Sacramento City Code, your application for a Massage Technician's permit has been denied.

The reason for the denial is that the Permit Application, Question 11, asks "Have you ever been arrested or convicted for other than minor traffic violations?" Your reply to this question was "no". The background investigation reveals that on 8/9/79 you were arrested by the San Mateo Police Department for 647(B) of the Penal Code, Prostitution and disorderly conduct.

Under Section 28.51, paragraph (b) of the Sacramento City Code, you have the right to appeal this decision. You may, within ten (10) days after the date of mailing of the decision, appeal such decision to the City Council by the filing of a written notice thereof with the City Clerk. If such appeal is not filed within ten (10) days, the decision of the Chief of Police shall be final.
