SUBJECT: Report Back - Status of County Budget Action Regarding  
Bannon Street and Front Street Facilities

SUMMARY

The Sacramento County government is not now contemplating any changes in the current programs at the two facilities named above.

BACKGROUND

Mr. Alex DeFields requested that the City Council investigate any contemplated reductions in funding or service at the two facilities.

As of Wednesday, August 4, the County Administration and Finance Agency reported as follows:

1. The Bannon Street Facility is carried in the budget as a contract administered by the County Welfare Department. No changes are proposed or recommended from current year activity.
2. The Front Street Facility is administered by the County Health Department. No reductions have been proposed. The Administration has identified a minor cut that can be made if the Board of Supervisors so desires but no cuts are recommended.

The budget messages to the Board of Supervisors were not available at the time this report was written but will be available for Council review at its regular meeting on Tuesday, August 10, 1982.

These matters will be before the Board of Supervisors as a part of County Final Budget hearings during the week of August 16-20, 1982.

RECOMMENDATION

No action is required of the Council at this time.
