**SUBJECT: RECOMMENDATION FOR ONE HOUR PARKING REGULATIONS ON
SANDBURG DRIVE FROM CARLSON DRIVE TO CAMELLIA WAY**

LOCATION & COUNCIL DISTRICT

Sandburg Drive from Carlson Drive to Camellia Way. Council District 3

SUMMARY

This report recommends the addition of one (1) hour parking time limits on both sides of Sandburg Drive from Carlson Drive to Camellia Way. (Exhibit A)

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the attached resolution be adopted to implement one-hour parking time limits on Sandburg Drive from Carlson Drive to Camellia Way.

BACKGROUND

Sandburg Drive is within walking distance of California State University. Students unwilling to pay the College parking fees use Sandburg Drive as a convenient source of free parking. Residents have experienced increasing difficulty parking near their homes. In order to protect the neighborhood from long term parking congestion, increased traffic, and associated problems the residents have submitted a petition representing 75% of the residential units, requesting that one-hour parking time limits be implemented.

A letter was sent to all of the addresses on this street segment outlining the request and soliciting comments.

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FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is \$200 for the installation of regulatory signing. Funds are available in the Traffic Signs and Marking Operational Budget (101-310-3122-4471).

POLICY CONSIDERATION

This recommendation is consistent with Sacramento City Code 25.109 which provides for regulation of parking on any street designated by resolution of the City Council.

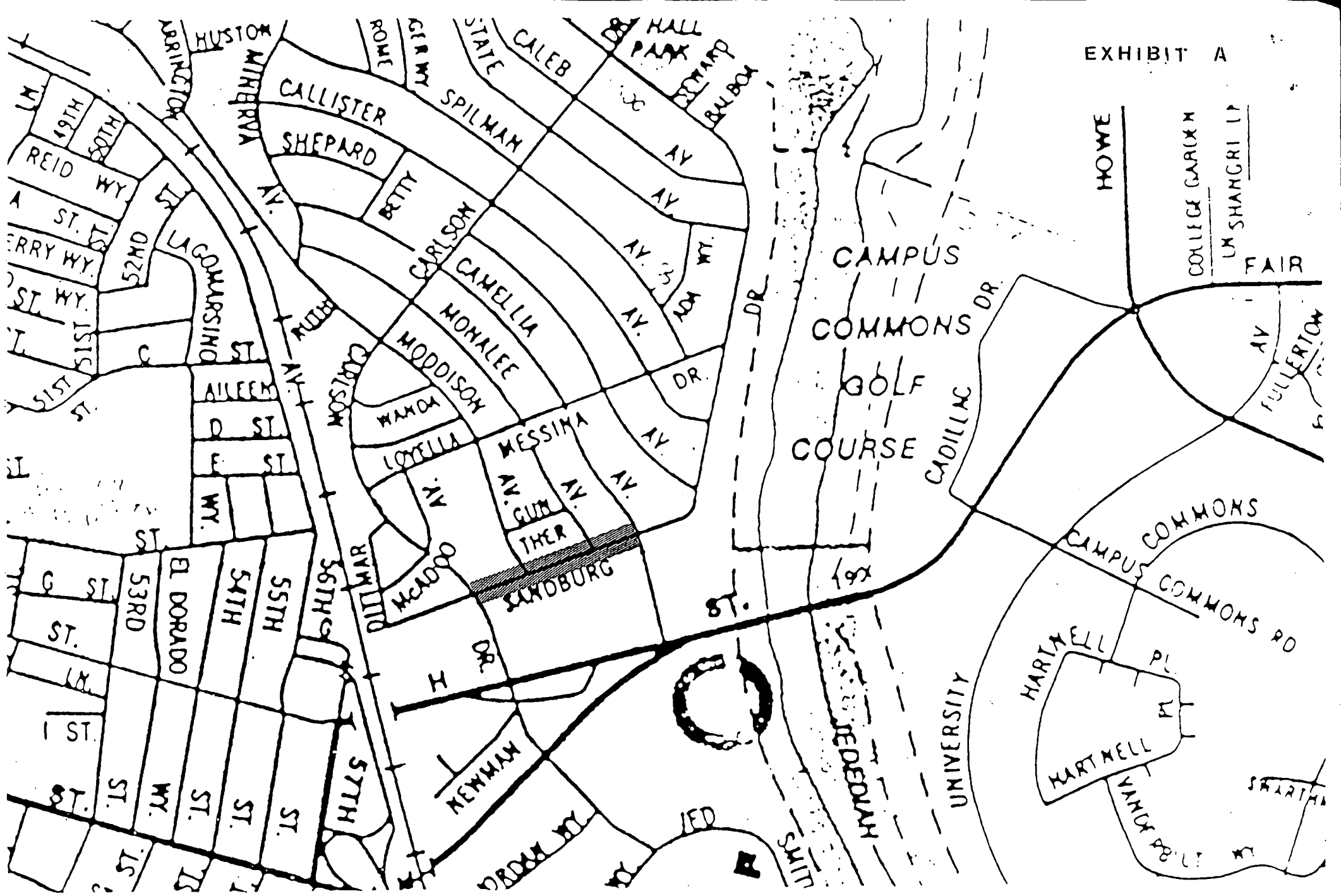

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PARKING TIME LIMITS ON BOTH SIDES OF SANDBURG DRIVE FROM CARLSON DRIVE TO CAMELLIA WAY

Whereas, pursuant to Section 25.109 of the Sacramento City Code when authorized signs have been placed giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand, or park any vehicle upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets for a period of time longer than specified on the signs;

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

The following streets shall be regulated by one-hour parking time limits from 8:00 a.m to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday

- Sandburg Drive, both sides, from Carlson Drive to Camellia Way.
