LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

20-28TH Street • (City of Sacramento Landfill) • Council District #3

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution for the final balancing Change Order to contract number CO 97-153 with Yubacon Inc/R.J. Gordon Construction, Inc. The contract will increase by \$181,245.60. It also recommends that City Council approve amending the Capital Improvement Program (CIP) by transferring \$160,000 from the Groundwater Remediation CIP (YB36) to the Landfill Closure CIP YA06.

SUMMARY:

This project was mandated by the Notice and Stipulated Order of Compliance issued by the County of Sacramento Environmental Management Department Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) on July 17, 1995, and revised on August 15, 1996.

This final change order was needed for additional gas piping and materials, increased contract items, and added erosion control blanket.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Pertinent information regarding the City's landfill closure program is summarized below:

- The construction project to comply with the above-referenced Notice and Stipulated Order of Compliance was awarded following a competitive bidding to Yubacon Inc./R.J. Gordon Construction, Inc. on March 18, 1997.
- The work included construction of a low permeability cover over the waste, revegetation, access road, bike trail, drainage and landfill gas collection and monitoring system.
- This is the final, balancing change order resulting from the final quantity estimates.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The original contract was for \$1,799,464.55. The first change order was for \$239,965, which was about 13 percent of the contract, and it was to modify the landfill gas collection wells due to the high groundwater levels encountered at the landfill. This balancing change order is an additional 10 percent of the initial contract, and it is mostly due to settlement that occurred on the landfill since 1995, the date on the design plans and specifications.

The unobligated fund balance in the Landfill Closure CIP YA06 is \$22,903.88. The Groundwater Remediation CIP YB36 includes funds set aside in the event of necessity for closure of the landfill. The available fund balance in YB36 is \$509,978.72. It is recommended \$160,000 be transferred from YB36 to YA06.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

In accordance with the State Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) of 1970, the Planning Services Division, Environmental Section has reviewed the closure and prepared a Negative Declaration.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

Federal and state regulation requires the City to close its landfill in accordance with Federal and State regulations. Compliance with the above is consistent with the City Council's priority, regarding public safety.

MBE/WBE:

All MBE/WBE requirements that were in place at the time the contract was awarded (March 18, 1997) were met.
