SUBJECT: Oakmont Avenue Water Main (PN:ZC06) - Project Approval and Bid
Advertisement

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

The residences along Oakmont Avenue are currently serviced by a three (3) inch diameter water main which is undersized and in a deteriorated condition. This project will replace the existing water main with a six (6) inch diameter main and provide new water services.

This project was advertised for bid in October, 1987. The low bid was 52% above the engineers' estimate and all bids were rejected. The project has now been re-evaluated and it is believed that all bids received at this time will be more competitive.

A Categorical Exemption for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on September 15, 1987. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$35,800.

FINANCIAL

Additional funds will be needed for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$43,500. The current budget is \$25,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Water Funds. Additional funds are available in the Miscellaneous Water Main Improvements account (ZB31) and a recommendation to transfer the needed funds will be made following receipt of bids.


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A non-refundable fee of \$15.00 will be charged for each set of plans and specifications to cover reproduction costs.
