

## **RESOLUTION 2024-0296**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

October 8, 2024

### **Budgetary Adjustments and Professional Services Agreement for the Sacramento Valley Station Regional Commuter Bus Stops Project (T15029000)**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. From 2021 to 2022, with funds from Cycle 4 of the Transit and Intercity Rail Capital Program (TIRCP), the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) conducted a study for route consolidation that integrates regional commuter bus routes into a unified route that serves both the Sacramento Valley Station and the planned Valley Rail service Midtown Station.
- B. The study recommended 17 stop locations that would co-locate bus agencies and provide a maximum 7-minute pedestrian walk from the existing employment centers which the current stops serve. This would result in a 50% reduction in the total number of stop locations that will allow the city to improve curb management for parking and other curbside needs.
- C. The City of Sacramento successfully applied for a TIRCP grant in the fifth cycle for a suite of improvements to the SVS and its operations, one of which was the implementation of these enhanced bus stops.
- D. The Sacramento Valley Station (SVS) Regional Commuter Bus Stops Project (T15029000) will construct 17 new enhanced bus stops serving the region's bus commute service agencies to/from Downtown Sacramento in a route consolidation that integrates regional commuter routes into a unified route that serves both the Sacramento Valley Station and the planned Valley Rail service Midtown Station.
- E. The City conducted a formal procurement process to retain a qualified professional engineering firm to complete preliminary engineering and environmental clearance for the Project. Based on the merits of their written proposals, a panel consisting of City staff is recommending awarding the contract to the top ranked firm, ARUP US, Inc.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.**

The City Manager or the City Manager’s designee is authorized to increase the revenue and expenditures budget of the Sacramento Valley Station (SVS) Regional Bus Stops Project (T15029000) by \$2,000,000 (CIP Reimbursable Fund, Fund 3702)

**SECTION 2.**

The City Manager or the City Manager’s designee is authorized to execute a professional services agreement with ARUP US, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$499,900 for preliminary engineering and environmental clearance of the Sacramento Valley Station (SVS) Regional Bus Stops Project (T15029000).
