SUBJECT: Ordinance Amending Section 25.5 and Various Other Sections of Chapter 25 of the Sacramento City Code Relating to Duties of the Traffic Engineer and Parking Manager

SUMMARY:

Presented herewith is an Ordinance amending Section 25.5 and various other sections of Chapter 25 of the Sacramento City Code relating to duties of the Traffic Engineer and Parking Manager.

BACKGROUND:

Prior to the reorganization of the Public Works Department, the Traffic Engineer was also the Director of Parking and was responsible for all parking matters. The Parking Manager is now responsible for parking matters and it is necessary to make the appropriate changes in Chapter 25 of the City Code. Most of the changes are merely changing "Traffic Engineer" to "Parking Manager" in those sections of Chapter 25 dealing with parking.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that this item be passed for publication of title and continued to December 13th for adoption of the Ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 83-155

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 25.5 AND VARIOUS OTHER SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 25 OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE RELATING TO DUTIES OF THE TRAFFIC ENGINEER AND PARKING MANAGER

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

Section 25.5 of Chapter 25 of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 25.5 City Traffic Engineer and Parking Manager - Powers and Duties.

The City Traffic Engineer shall: determine the installation and proper timing and maintenance of traffic-control devices and signals; conduct engineering analyses of traffic accidents and devise remedial measures; conduct engineering investigation of traffic conditions and co-operate with other City officials in the development of ways and means to improve traffic conditions; and carry out the additional powers and duties imposed by this chapter and other ordinances of the City.

The Parking Manager shall manage and operate the public off-street parking facilities, direct parking studies of off-street and on-street parking needs, plans and facilities, and perform related duties.

SECTION 2.

Sections 25.109, 25.112, 25.113, 25.115, 25.116, 25.117, 25.118, 25.119, 25.120, 25.121, 25.122, 25.123, 25.127, 25.131, 25.134, 25.136, 25.151, 25.154, 25.155, 25.156, 25.157, 25.158, 25.170, 25.171, 25.172, 25.173, 25.174, 25.175, 25.176, 25.177, 25.178, 25.180, 25.183, 25.186, and 25.187 of the Sacramento City Code are hereby amended to change "Traffic Engineer," "City Traffic Engineer" and "Parking Director" wherever such terms occur in each of said sections to "Parking Manager".
