This letter is in response to your call regarding the lack of spacing between the plywood deck on the above mentioned job. Owens Corning recommends plywood decks have a minimum 1/8" space between all joints to minimize buckling. An exception will be made to allow no spacing between the joints in the plywood for the above mentioned job, all other jobs must adhere to our recommendations of a minimum 1/8" spacing between all joints.

Owens Corning will warrant our shingles within the conditions stated in our written warranty only for the above mentioned job under conditions stated above. Please keep in mind our warranty does not cover workmanship, only manufacturing defects in the material. Any problems that may occur such as buckling due to no spacing between the joints in the plywood is the sole responsibility of Gudger/Yancey Roofing.

APA and its member companies are pleased to provide the following engineered wood product information. This information is the result of extensive product testing and application research. Our product use and application recommendations are based on design values, product characteristics and field performance that apply only to *APA* and *EWS* trademarked products and may not be applicable to wood products carrying other marks. Please support the companies that make this information available to you by specifying and purchasing only engineered wood products with the *APA* or *EWS* trademark.

The following is in response to your inquiry regarding APA recommendations for gapping joints of shear panels.

As stated in APA literature: 1/8 inch spacing is recommended at all panel edge joints unless otherwise indicated by the manufacturer. Spacing of panels is recommended to minimize the risk of panel buckling when panels are exposed to moisture during construction or acclimatize after installation. Buckling is considered a serviceability issue and does not affect structural capacity. In dry climates, it may be possible to butt panels to a light contact based upon satisfactory past field experience, but the contractor is at risk if a buckling problem develops. Spacing of panels is not a mandatory building code requirement.

It may be very difficult to determine if panels were properly spaced at the time of installation. If the panels were dry at the time of installation and subsequently acclimatized to a higher moisture content the space (gap) will be diminished. The gap may even be fully closed if moisture conditions were high enough to cause significant panel expansion.
