LOCATION: 4324 - 77th Street

SUMMARY:

This is a request to divide a .45 acre site into two separate parcels. The purpose of the division is to allow two existing dwellings to be located on individual lots. The staff and Subdivision Review Committee recommended approval of the request subject to conditions.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This request does not necessitate review by the Planning Commission because there are no concurrent requests for special permit, rezoning, or plan amendment. Therefore, the application was submitted directly to the City Council for consideration.

Surrounding land use and zoning are as follows:

North: Single family; and R-1 South: Single family; and R-1 East: Single family; and R-1

West: Multiple family; and R-1

The Environmental Coordinator has determined that the proposed project will not have a significant adverse effect on the environment; therefore, this project is exempt from the provisions of CEQA.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Parcel Map Advisory Agency (Planning Director and City Engineer), based upon review

by the Subdivision Review Committee, recommends that the City Council approve the project by adopting the attached resolution adopting findings of fact, approving the Tentative Map with conditions.

RESOLUTION ADOPTING FINDINGS OF FACT, APPROVING
A REQUEST FOR TENTATIVE MAP FOR PROPERTY LOCATED AT ROVED
4324 - 77th STREET (APN: 021-271-05)(P-9571)

BY THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Parcel Map Advisory Agency has submitted to the City Council its report and recommendations concerning the Tentative Map for property located at 4324 - 77th Street,

(hereinafter referred to as the proposed subdivision).

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Sacramento, based on testimony submitted at public hearing(s) conducted on March 30, 1982, hereby finds and determines as follows:

- A. The proposed subdivision, together with the provisions for its design and improvement, is consistent with the City General Plan and the Colonial Community Plan in that the plans designate the subject site for residential uses.
- B. The site is physically suitable for the type and proposed density of development in that the subject site is flat with no significant erosional, soil expansion, or other similar problems.
- C. The design of the subdivision or proposed improvements are not likely to cause substantial environmental damage and will not substantially and avoidably injure fish, wildlife, or their habitat. The proposed project has been reviewed and assessed by the Environmental Coordinator, who has determined that the proposed project will not cause individual or cumulative adverse effects on the natural and social-physical environment or substantially and avoidably injure fish, wildlife, or their habitat pursuant to CEQA, Section 15115.
- D. The design of the subdivision or the type of improvements are not likely to cause serious public health problems in that community water and sewer systems exist at the site. The site is not within an established floodplain or over a known seismic fault.
- E. The design of the subdivision or the type of improvements will not conflict with easements acquired by the public for access through, or use of, the property within the proposed subdivision, in that there are no access easements for use by the public at large on the subject site.

- F. The discharge of waste from the proposed subdivision into the community sewer system servicing the proposed subdivision will not result in or add to a violation of the waste discharge requirements applicable to said sewer system which were prescribed by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region, in that the existing City of Sacramento treatment plants have a design capacity of 75 mgd and that actual treated discharge averages 56 mgd. The discharge from the proposed project will not create a condition exceeding the design capacity.
- G. The design of the proposed subdivision provides, to the extent feasible, for future passive or natural heating or cooling opportunities in the proposed subdivision, taking into consideration the local climate, the contour and configuration of the parcel to be divided, and such other design and improvement requirements applicable to the proposed subdivision.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Sacramento as follows:

The Tentative Map be approved subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Pursuant to City Code Section 40.1302 (Parkland Dedication), the applicant shall submit to the City an appraisal of the property to be subdivided and pay the required parkland dedication in-lieu fees. The appraisal shall be dated not more than 90 days prior to the filing of the final map.
- 2. Show existing sewer and water services; separate services required. Hook up and install services prior to filing final map or dedicate reciprocal easements as required by City Engineering.

> Adopted a Resolution adopting findings of Fact and approving a Tentative Map to divide .45± acre into 2 parcels in the R-1 Single Family Zone






