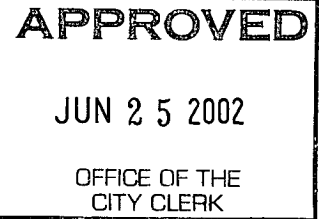

**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF CONTRACT EXTENSION (CHANGE ORDER) FOR CRACK SEALING AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS**

**SUMMARY:**

Crack sealing is a process required in preparation for the next season's resurfacing. Street Operations' contract for crack sealing includes various locations throughout the City already identified for the next annual street-resurfacing program. This extension of the contract allows for the continuation of this successful program. We are currently using the contractor Northern California Crack Sealing, who was awarded the bid under the formal bidding process.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

City Council awarded the contract for crack sealing to Northern California Crack Sealing on June 13, 2000. The contractor provides the equipment and labor used in filling the cracks in selected streets, the city provides the material, inspection and traffic control.

This project was previously authorized in the Capital Improvement Program RI11. In fiscal year 2002/03, the project has been included in the Street Operations annual budget for \$300,000.00.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

- The project budget is \$300,000.00
- The unobligated fund balance for the Street Maintenance Organization (101-310-3191-4258) is sufficient for this award.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The current project has been determined to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under section 15301 (c) which states that repair and maintenance of existing highways and streets involving negligible or no expansion of existing use is exempt.


**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**
