ORDINANCE NO. 734, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10 OF ORDINANCE NO. 18, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED SEPTEMBER 22, 1921, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR LICENSING AND REGULATING THE CARRYING ON OF CERTAIN PROFESSIONS, TRADES, CALLINGS AND OCCUPATIONS; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE, TO TAKE EFFECT OCTOBER 1st, 1921."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Section 10 of Ordinance No. 18, Fourth Series, passed September 22, 1921, is hereby amended to read as follows:

RENEWAL AND PENALTY.

SECTION 10. In all cases of renewal of licenses the fee therefor shall be paid before the expiration of the expiring license and in the event of failure to make such payment within said time, the Controller shall add the following penalty to the fee for such renewal, to-wit:

Ten per cent on all licenses if not paid within fifteen days after the first day on which such license may become due.

Said penalty shall be a charge upon, and collectible at the time of issuance of such license, from the person conducting business and liable for such license in accordance with this ordinance.
