SUMMARY

Construction staking is required for this development project. Approval of the consultant agreement with the Spink Corporation for this work is recommended.

BACKGROUND

Construction survey staking is required during construction for street grading, curb and paving, sewer, water, drainage and street lights. The sites are located near Rush River Drive and Little River Way in the Pocket Area.


