### SUMMARY

The Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission, on behalf of the Sacramento Transit Development Agency (STDA) requests approval to submit an application to the National Endowment for the Arts for a grant of \$6150 to underwrite one half of the costs of an exhibition of the artworks selected for the Light Rail system. The exhibition is planned from May 15 to June 30, 1986.

### BACKGROUND

The Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission is administering an art program for STDA. The artworks are scheduled to be installed when the system is operational in 1987. To assist in a public relations effort for Light Rail and to give the public an opportunity to view all of the artworks together, an exhibition of the artists' proposals is being planned for May-June 1986. A catalogue will be printed including descriptions of each of the artworks and statements by the artists. This will serve to document the project and provide the basic information for future Light Rail public relations efforts.

The National Endowment for the Arts through its Museum Program offers on a competitive basis matching funds for exhibitions. In response to a preliminary inquiry, the NEA has informed the Arts Commission that the application is appropriate and will receive due consideration.

### FINANACIAL DATA

This grant requires a fifty percent (50%) match in funds. The Arts Commission has funds in its 85/86 budget and will raise private donations to cover the \$6150 match.

No additional City General Funds are requested.


