

SUBJECT: Continuation of Tram Service for K Street Mall
and Old Sacramento

SUMMARY

This report recommends that the City Council, through a new agreement with the Sacramento Downtown Association, support the continuation of tram services provided by Sacramento Regional Transit on the K Street Mall and in Old Sacramento. This report was reviewed by the Budget and Finance Committee on August 5, 1986.

BACKGROUND

The City, in cooperation with the Sacramento Downtown Association agreed to financially support the reinstatement of the Tram Service for the K Street Mall and Old Sacramento on November 9, 1983.

The City and the Association, with cooperation of Regional Transit have tentatively agreed to a new service contract for the period of one year beginning June 1, 1986 through May 31, 1986. All provisions of the contract between the City and Sacramento Downtown Association are identical to the previous year's agreement except for a 5% increase in City contribution.

FINANCIAL DATA

The total cost to the City to continue the tram service on the K Street Mall and in Old Sacramento is \$19,000, including a 5% increase for a period of one year beginning June 1, 1986 and ending May 31, 1986. This funding, as previously adopted in the 1986-87 Approved Budget, shall be provided by the Transit Support operating budget.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Council approve the attached agreement and authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement on behalf of the City to provide a contribution of \$19,000 to Sacramento Downtown Association for the continuation of tram services on K Street Mall and in Old Sacramento.

AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into this _____ day of _____, 1986, by and between the City of Sacramento, a municipal corporation ("City"), and the Sacramento Downtown Association, a California nonprofit corporation ("Association").

WHEREAS, Association has entered into a contract with the Sacramento Regional Transit District ("RT") under which RT will reinstate tram service on the K Street Mall.

WHEREAS, Association, under its agreement with RT is obligated to pay RT an estimated sum of \$28,000 for one year of tram service commencing June 1, 1986.

WHEREAS, City desires to contribute \$19,000 to the Association for the purpose of helping to meet the Association's obligation to RT regarding the tram service.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. City agrees to pay the Association the sum of \$19,000, payable under the following terms and conditions:

a. payments will be made in four equal installments of \$4,750.00 on August 31, 1986; November 30, 1986; February 28, 1987; and May 31, 1987.

2. City and Association expressly agree that RT is not and is not intended to be a third party creditor or donee beneficiary of this agreement.

3. Association, its officers, agents, and employees in the performance of this agreement shall act in an independent capacity and not as officers, agents, or employees of the City.

4. Association, shall assume all responsibility for its performance or failure to perform under this agreement and shall bear all losses and damages directly or indirectly resulting to it or to the City, its officers, agents and employees resulting from Association's performance or failure to perform under this agreement.

5. Association shall assume the defense of and indemnify and hold harmless the City, its officers, agents and employees from all claims, loss, damage, injury and liability of every kind, nature and description, including punitive damages directly or indirectly resulting from Association's performance or failure to perform this agreement.

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

CONTINUATION OF TRAM SERVICES TO THE K STREET MALL AND OLD SACRAMENTO

WHEREAS, Regional Transit District has agreed to continue tram service to the K Street Mall and Old Sacramento for the period of one year, and;

WHEREAS, The Sacramento Downtown Association will contract with Regional Transit District to provide a subsidy for the mall tram service for an amount not to exceed \$28,000 for one year's service, and;

WHEREAS, 68% of the amount, or \$19,000, is needed to assure the financial feasibility for the tram service, therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That, the City Manager is authorized to execute an agreement on behalf of the City to provide a contribution to Sacramento Downtown Association for the continuation of tram service on the K Street Mall and in Old Sacramento for the period of one year (June 1, 1986 through May 31, 1987), and;

That funding as previously adopted in the 1986-87 Approved Budget shall be provided by the Transit Support operating budget.
