SUBJECT: 1985-86 Arts in Education Grant Application -
National Endowment for the Arts

SUMMARY

The Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission requests approval to submit a grant application to the National Endowment for the Arts for \$14,000 to help local districts and schools maintain a system for ongoing Arts in Education programs.

BACKGROUND

Locally, area schools have had little access to artists' services. Local artists, professionally trained for Arts in Education work, have had little success in infiltrating the local market. Because of the inherent lack of information for schools due to their non-participatory role in the field, Arts in Education has not reached its potential locally. This grant, if funded, would enable the Artreach program to positively impact the climate of Arts in Education by: 1) providing assistance to the districts on a regular basis; 2) publication of an artists/agency resource directory listing pertinent data in this field; and 3) further training and orientation to local parent/teacher associations in generating viable funding systems.


FINANCIAL DATA

This grant requires a fifty percent match in funds. These matching funds will come from the private corporate sector.
