SUBJECT: Recommendation for Funding Residential Permit Parking for

Alkali Flats Area

SUMMARY

This report recommends funding for implementation of Residential Permit Parking in the Alkali Flats Area (map attached).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

In April 1981 after adopting a resolution to approve a negative declaration, the City Council adopted a resolution tentatively establishing a Residential Permit Parking Program for the Alkali Flats Area. The implementation of the program was contingent upon the receipt of a final supplementary petition representing over 50% of the residences within the area.

On December 4, 1981, the Traffic Engineer received the final petition, representing 54.7% of the residences in the area boundaries as supporting this program. The Alkali Flats Residential Permit Parking area boundaries are 7th Street, I Street, 16th Street and the SPRR.

On December 22, 1981, the Budget & Finance Committee reviewed and approved this recommendation.

It is recommended that the 1981-82 fiscal year budget be amended by adopting the attached Resolution.



A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY BUDGET FOR 1981-82 FOR THE ALKALI FLATS RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING PROGRAM

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

- 1. There are adequate funds in the CDBG Year #7 Contingency Allocation to pay \$9,150 for implementing the Alkali Flats Residential Permit Parking Program.
- 2. The City Budget for the 1981-82 Fiscal Year is hereby amended by appropriating \$9,150 from the CDBG Year #7 Contingency Allocation to the Traffic Engineering Budget (1-01-3110-8359-XXXX) to pay the 1981-82 costs of the Alkali Flats Residential Parking Permit Program.
