SUBJECT: Recovering of Convention Center Folding Chairs

SUMMARY

This report concerns the issuance of a purchase order funded by the Community Center Joint Authority Construction Fund for the purpose of recovering approximately 6,900 folding chairs owned by the Convention Center, and is provided for the City Council's information.

BACKGROUND

The Convention Center purchased approximately 6,900 metal folding chairs with a foam pad and fabric cover when the facility first opened in 1974. These chairs have been used with such a frequency that it is now necessary to replace the pads and covers. This project is being coordinated with the redecorating of the Convention Center.

Bids were solicited from a variety of companies for labor only in replacing the pads and covers. The Developmental Disabled Service Organization of Sacramento, California, an organization dedicated to the training and rehabilitation of the developmentally disabled, submitted the lowest bid. It is anticipated that the cost of this project will not exceed \$22,750.



No funds from the Convention Center's Operating Budget will be expended on this project.


