

ORDINANCE NO. 514, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ADVERTISING IN THE PUBLIC STREETS OR IN VEHICLES WITH ANIMALS, BANNERS, TRANSPARENCIES OR FRAME WORK; ALSO PROHIBITING THE BEATING UPON GONGS, RINGING OF BELLS, OR THE PLAYING OF DRUMS OR MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS, VICTROLAS OR RADIOS ON VEHICLES IN THE PUBLIC STREETS; ALSO PROHIBITING THE VOICE OR OTHER SOUND AMPLIFIERS BROADCASTING ON OR INTO THE PUBLIC STREETS; PROHIBITING THE USE OF ANY ATTACHMENT OF ANY VEHICLE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PRODUCING UNNECESSARY NOISE AND PROHIBITING ANY UNNECESSARY NOISE OF ANY NATURE IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, EXCEPTING PUBLIC CELEBRATIONS ON HOLIDAYS AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 474, PASSED SEPTEMBER 20, 1897.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to cause or permit to be carried, hauled or drawn on any dray, wagon or other vehicles, on any public street of the City of Sacramento, any animal, banner, transparency, frame work, or any other device intendant or intending or purporting to be used as an advertisement or for the purpose of advertising any business, exhibition, place of amusement or entertainment, cause and/or propaganda having a tendency to disturb the peace, distract attention, impede and/or obstruct or hinder traffic, without first obtaining a permit so to do from the Chief of Police of said Sacramento City.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation on a dray, wagon, or other vehicle on the public streets of the City of Sacramento to beat upon gongs, ring bells or play drums, or musical instruments, or phonographs or radios having a tendency to disturb the peace, distract attention and/or impede, obstruct or hinder traffic, without first obtaining a permit so to do from the Chief of Police of said Sacramento City.

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm

or corporation to broadcast from a radio, phonograph or similar instrument using voice or sound amplifiers, into the public thoroughfare from a fixed location.

SECTION 4. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to produce any unnecessary noise of any nature where- in the producing of noise alone is the object to be attained.

SECTION 5. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to attach to any vehicle for the purpose of produc- ing unnecessary noise any cans, bells, pans, iron or other metal and/or any other noise producing attachment whatsoever.

SECTION 6. Public celebrations and public functions on public holidays or other occasions generally celebrated, and special broadcasts of events of interest to the general public are hereby excepted from the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 7. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail not exceeding 5 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.


SECTION 8. Ordinance No. 474, passed September 20, 1997, is hereby repealed.
