

ORDINANCE NO. 768, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING
A PORTION OF 24TH STREET, LYING BETWEEN THE
SOUTHERLY LINE OF CASTRO WAY AND THE ALLEY FIRST
SOUTH OF CASTRO WAY, IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. A portion of 24th Street, lying between the
southerly line of Castro Way and the alley first south of Castro
Way, in the City of Sacramento; being more particularly described
as follows, to-wit:


Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 1 in Block "F"
of "Highland Park" (as the same is shown on the official
map or plat thereof filed in the office of the County
Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of Calif-
ornia); which said point is further described as being
located south, $64^{\circ} 35.69'$ west, 56.55 feet from a mon-
ument marking the center line intersection of Castro Way
and 24th Street, in said City; thence from the point of
beginning south, $19^{\circ} 34.25'$ west, 120.00 feet along the
easterly line of said Lot 1, to the southeast corner
thereof; thence south, $70^{\circ} 23.25'$ east, 24.94 feet along
the easterly production of the southerly line of said
Lot 1, to a point; thence north $89^{\circ} 52.00'$ east, 30.59
feet, to a point; thence north, 116.42 feet along a line
parallel to, and distant 34.50 feet at right angles
westerly from, the present center line (between curbs)
of 24th Street, to a point; thence north, $70^{\circ} 23.25'$
west, 14.73 feet along a line parallel to, and distant
40.00 feet at right angles southerly from, the center
line of Castro Way, to the point of beginning; and
containing 4161.00 square feet, more or less,

is hereby declared, closed, vacated and abandoned.

Said closing, vacating and abandoning is declared after
due proceedings had therefor according to law.
