SUBJECT: Council Approval to Apply for a Historic Preservation Planning Grant

SUMMARY

The Office of Historic Preservation has indicated to staff that Planning Grant funds are available to produce publications, which informed the public about preservation programs. The Preservation Board has \$5,000 in the fiscal year 1979-80 budget, which may be used as the dollar portion of the City's match to secure a \$16,000 grant from the O.H.P. The submittal of an application does not bind the City into a contractual arrangement with the O.H.P., but merely earmarks the Federal Funds for Sacramento's use should the Council later agree to enter into a contract with the State Office of Historic Preservation.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff requests Council approval to submit an application in order to place a hold on these funds for Sacramento's use.
