SUMMARY

Plans and Specifications for this project have been prepared and copies forwarded to the City Clerk. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

The extension of 2nd Street between "L" Street and Neasham Circle will permit two-way traffic to flow through that 2nd Street section. This will provide an additional traffic exit from the Old Sacramento Area to be used especially in times of high traffic congestion.

FINANCIAL

The funding for this project in the amount of \$42,000 from the Major Street Construction Fund has been requested in the 1985/86 Capital Improvement program. The estimated construction cost for the project is \$40,000. It is proposed that any additional funds that might be needed be transferred from the miscellaneous improvement account for this project. However, the final budgetary recommendation will be made following receipt of bids. Although the funding for this project will not be available until the budget is approved, it is proposed that the project be advertised for bids at this time so that the bids will be received and the contract may be awarded shortly after the 1st of July, 1985.


It is recommended that the plans and specifications be approved and the City Clerk be authorized to advertise for bids to be received on June 11, 1985.
