PROPOSAL: Rehabilitation of a Listed Structure.

BACKGROUND: Applicant is requesting a Planning Director's Variance to waive the 6' high solid masonry wall requirement on the east and west property line. Applicant is also requesting a Variance to exceed the 3' high fence limit in the front yard setback area.

City Planning Department staff has requested that the Preservation Board review the proposed fence design.

PROJECT INFORMATION: Applicant proposes to construct an iron and brick fence measuring 6' along the front yard. Along the side yards, applicant proposes to construct a wooden fence measuring 5'6".

EVALUATION: Staff feels that both the wooden and masonry fences are appropriate in design and will compliment the structure.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends that the Board approve the project with the following condition:

1. That the iron part of the fence be composed of wrought iron rather than hollow square tubing.

Approval is based on the following Findings of Fact:

- 1. The fence designs relate well to the historic structure and will have a positive impact on the surrounding area.
- 2. The use of wrought iron rather than hollow iron tubing will allow for a more historic feeling to the fence.
