Subject: Approval of a Cost Sharing Street Lighting Conservation Program Agreement on State Routes Within the City Limits and Authorizing the City Manager to Execute the Agreement on Behalf of the City by Passage of the Attached Resolution and Authorizing the Transferring of the State Contribution from The Discretionary Reserve Fund to the Subject Program by passage of the Attached Resolution

### SUMMARY

As part of the 1982-1983 Street Lighting Conversion Program, Staff has proposed to convert the mercury vapor luminaires located on State routes within the City limits to high pressure sodium vapor luminaires. The State has agreed to share in the cost of this program.

It is recommended that the attached Cost Sharing Agreement be approved and the attached resolution be passed authorizing the City Manager to execute this agreement on behalf of the City. It is also recommended that \$79,000 from the Discretionary Reserve Fund be transferred to the program to provide funding for the State's share by passage of the attached resolution.

### BACKGROUND

The City has, since the Fiscal Year 1978/1979, been involved in a street lighting conversion program to change the existing mercury vapor luminaires to the more energy efficient lower wattage high pressure sodium vapor luminaires.

As part of the 1981-1982 and 1982-1983 conversion programs we have included luminaires on City streets that are designated as State routes. These are State Routes 5, 16, 50, 51, 80, 99, 160, 275. The State has agreed to participate financially in changing these luminaires located on State routes.

### FINANCIAL

Fiscal Year 1981-1982 the City and State entered into an agreement (Resolution No. 81-928) whereby the State agreed to participate in the amount up to \$37,000 as their portion in the project.


In Fiscal Year 1982-1983 the State has agreed to participate in the amount up to \$42,000. The total amount of State participation for the Fiscal Years 1981-1982 and 1982-1983 is \$79,000.

RECOMMENDATION

The City Engineer recommends that the subject agreement between the City of Sacramento and the State of California for the Cost Sharing of the Street Lighting Conversion Program be approved and the City Manager be authorized and directed to execute the Agreement by passage of the attached resolution.

The City Engineer further recommends that \$79,000 of Discretionary Reserve funds be transferred to the Street Lighting Conversion Program by passage of the attached resolution.
