Operations for FY 1981-82

SUMMARY

The attached resolution authorizes the execution of grant contracts, and amendments thereto, with the Area 4 Agency on Aging/Community Services Planning Council, Inc., for Title III, Older Americans Act funds for the Sacramento Elderly Nutrition Program's FY 1981-82 operations, and maintenance of current service levels until October 1, 1981.

BACKGROUND

On June 23, 1981, you asked staff to report back on July 21, 1981, on the funding status for FY 81-82 of the Elderly Nutrition Program.

Grant contracts, totaling \$629,111 in Title III, Older Americans Act funds, have been released by the Area 4 Agency on Aging/ Community Services Planning Council on July 1, 1981, for the FY 81-82 operations of the Sacramento Elderly Nutrition Program (SENP). The grants awarded equal the balanced "Budget C" presented to you at the June 23, 1981, meeting, which requires a reduction in both the congregate and home-delivered meals, the closing of 4 additional congregate meal sites, a reduction in transportation services, and the layoff of one permanent full-time and 4 part-time staff members, effective July 1, 1981.

In accordance with your request at the June 23, 1981, meeting, the required service level and staff reductions have not been effected.

On July 14, 1981, staff appeared before the Community Services Planning Council Board of Directors with a request for \$22,004 in additional Title III funds required for maintenance of current service levels until October 1, 1981. The amount requested represents an adjustment of "Budget B", reflecting additional cost savings. The additional \$22,004 were approved in view of a substantial FY 80-81 projected fund balance for SENP.

The additional funds provide for the minimum amount required for SENP to maintain current service levels until October 1, 1981. Current service levels are 900 meals per day at 15 congregate nutrition sites and to 150 homebound seniors; transportation services in four service areas; and shopping assistance in three service areas.

Attached is a staffing chart showing FY 80-81 staffing of SENP and current staffing, including filled and vacant positions. We will not be able to fill the vacant positions unless more funds are made available. The non-replacement of the two already closed sites and overall staff reductions required to reduce costs will require utilizing less temporary help.

Additional funds to maintain service levels and essential staff positions beyond October 1, 1981, may be available at such time as the Area 4 Agency on Aging has received more reliable information from the Department of Aging regarding additional FY 81-82 Older Americans Act funds, and close-out audits for FY 80-81 are completed, establishing the level of carry-over funds available to the Area Agency for re-allocation to service providers.

FINANCIAL DATA

Total Title III, Older Americans Act funds granted for FY 81-82 operations of SENP, including the additional \$22,004 grant, are \$651,115. A 10% local match is required, which is available through the proposed FY 81-82 County General Fund grant and in-kind contributions of volunteer time and free use of facilities for nutrition sites.

No additional personnel is required by the attached resolution.

AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF CONTRACTS AND CONTRACT AMENDMENTS WITH AREA 4 AGENCY ON AGING/COMMUNITY SERVICES PLANNING COUNCIL AND APPROVING STAFF POSITIONS AND SERVICE LEVELS SACRAMENTO ELDERLY NUTRITION PROGRAM

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. The Interim Executive Director is authorized to execute fiscal year 1981-82 grant contracts with the Area 4 Agency on Aging/Community Services Planning Council, Inc., for a total of Six Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand One Hundred Eleven Dollars (\$629,111) in Title III, Older Americans Act funds for the Sacramento Elderly Nutrition Program.

Section 2. The Interim Executive Director is authorized to execute amendments to these grant contracts for an additional Twenty-Two Thousand Four Dollars (\$22,004) in Title III, Older Americans Act funds granted by the Area 4 Agency on Aging/ Community Services Planning Council, Inc., for maintenance of current service levels of the Sacramento Elderly Nutrition Program until October 1, 1981.

Section 3. The staff positions and service levels for the Sacramento Elderly Nutrition Program, as presented in the Summary of Budget "B", as amended, are approved until October 1, 1981.
