

ORDINANCE NO. 81-100

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

NOV 4 - 1981

ORDINANCE RELATING TO COMPENSATION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AND DECLARING SAID ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1.

Section 2.128 of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 2.128 Compensation of Members.

(a) Each member of the redevelopment agency of the city shall receive as compensation the sum of fifty dollars for each commission meeting attended; provided, that the total compensation of each member shall not exceed two hundred fifty dollars in any one month. In addition, each such member shall receive necessary travelling and subsistence expenses incurred in the discharge of his duties.

(b) In addition to the compensation set forth in subsection (a) hereof, the chairman of the agency shall receive an expense reimbursement allowance of one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00) per month in recognition of the additional necessary travelling and subsistence expenses related to the discharge of his duties as chairman and without further documentation or itemization."

SECTION 2.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance to take effect immediately. The facts constituting the emergency are the need to provide for an equitable increase in compensation for members of the Redevelopment Agency at the earliest possible time.
