

ORDINANCE NO. 452, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 18, FOURTH SERIES, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR LICENSING AND REGULATING THE CARRYING ON OF CERTAIN PROFESSIONS, TRADES, CALLINGS AND OCCUPATIONS: PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND MAKING THIS AN AMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT OCTOBER 1st, 1921," AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 440, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED SEPTEMBER 12, 1929.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 18, Fourth Series, as amended by Ordinance No. 440, Fourth Series, Passed September 12, 1929, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 52 $\frac{1}{2}$. FUEL DEALERS.

For every person, firm or corporation conducting, managing or carrying on the business of selling, offering for sale, exposing for sale, vending, delivering, furnishing or dealing in wood, coal, blocks or any other material to be used or utilized for fuel purposes, \$20.00 per year, payable in advance, and for each and every person, firm or corporation conducting or managing more than one place of business a like sum for each additional place of business.

The provisions of this Section shall not apply to any person, firm or corporation who directly delivers wood, blocks or other material to be used or utilized for fuel purposes, the same being the product of his own land, provided, that said land is not leased or rented for the purpose of cutting and marketing the fuel thereon.

SECTION 2. The proper authorities shall remit and refund to persons, firms or corporations paying the license as provided by Section 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Ordinance 440, passed September 12, 1929, such portion of said license as therein provided, as the remaining period of the year bears to the entire year.

Provided, that none of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed or construed to include the sale, vending or delivering of gas or oil or any of its by-products.
