SUMMARY

This report recommends the annexation to the State Capitol Residential Permit Parking Area, the west side of 11th Street between N Street and the N-and-O-Street Alley and the east side of 11th Street between the N-and-O-Street Alley and O Street.

BACKGROUND

This Division has recently received inquiries from residents living at the Lewis Apartments, located on the southeast corner of 11th and N Streets requesting additional "On-Street" preferential permit parking spaces. The primary concern is that the apartment complex has 35 units and only ten (10) off-street parking spaces and five (5) on-street signed residential permit parking spaces. The reason this location has only five (5) on-street signed residential permit parking spaces is due to this Division's policy of not posting/signing the commercial or non-residential frontages within a residential permit parking area with the residential permit exemption. However, because this apartment complex is totally surrounded by State office buildings (non-residential) the

nearest ample on-street permit parking area is two and one-half blocks away and considering this area is already part of the State Capitol Residential Permit Parking boundary, we would recommend the posting/signing of the proposed locations into the Permit Parking Program.


FINANCIAL DATA

The costs to implement and maintain this small additional area can be absorbed into the existing budget.


RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the attached resolution incorporating the posting/signing of a portion of 11th Street into the State Capitol Residential Permit Parking Area be adopted.


