SUBJECT: Arts in Education Grant Application - California Arts Council

SUMMARY

The Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission requests approval for the submission of a grant application to the California Arts Council in the amount of \$6,145 to carry out a series of Arts in Education survey and development activities for this and twelve adjacent counties.

BACKGROUND

The Arts Commission, as a State/Local Partner with the California Arts Council (CAC) has been requested to facilitate a CAC Arts in Education project designed to enhance the ability of regional school districts to gain access to existing Arts in Education resources. This grant will cover the following project costs:

- 1) education and technical assistance to regional school districts and arts agencies via mini-workshops and conferences throughout the 1985-86 academic year;
- 2) a process for local artists interested in this field to receive small stipends to conduct sampler and artist/teacher in-service training activities for interested schools;
- 3) the publication of a regional artist in schools resource directory, itemizing available individuals and institutions interested in providing AIE programs;
- 4) partial coordinator salary.

FINANCIAL DATA

This grant contains no dollar match requirements and does not require additional City funds. If grant is awarded, expenditures for project will be reimbursed through the California Arts Council.
