

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING DIVISION 1 OF ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 15 OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE AUTHORIZING A PERMIT FEE FOR CHRISTMAS TREE LOTS AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1.

Division 1 of Article II of Chapter 15 of the Sacramento City Code is amended to add Section 15.206 to read as follows:

Sec. 15.206. Fees for Permits, Christmas Tree Lots.

A permit shall be obtained from the Chief of the Fire Prevention Bureau authorizing the operation of a temporary Christmas tree lot.

A fee of \$40 shall be charged for and paid as a prior condition to the issuance of a permit.

A refund of \$25 shall be made at the termination of sales activities upon condition that the lot is cleared of debris to the satisfaction of the Chief of the Fire Prevention Bureau.

SECTION 2.


This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is the advent of the Christmas Season.

SECTION 3.

This ordinance shall be published once in the official newspaper of the City of Sacramento within ten (10) days after its passage.
