SUBJECT: Appointing Special Police Officer to Enforce Certain Chapters of the City Code.

SUMMARY

The attached resolution designates a City staff member the authority to enforce certain Chapters of the City Code.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Zoning Investigator of the Planning Department who is responsible for enforcement of the Zoning Ordinance has recently completed a course in Arrest and Firearms. In order to carry out the enforcement function effectively, it is appropriate to designate the Zoning Investigator a Special Police Officer.

The specified sections of the Charter limited under this jurisdiction are:

- Appendix I (Zoning Ordinance)
- Chapter 44 (Trailer and Public Camps)
- Chapter 61 (Nuisance Code)



RESOLUTION NO.

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

RESOLUTION APPOINTING CERTAIN INDIVIDUAL
SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER FOR THE PURPOSE OF
ENFORCING CERTAIN CHAPTERS OF THE CITY CODE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1.

In order to enforce certain chapters of the City Code, the person hereinafter named is hereby appointed special police officer for the purpose of enforcing those particular chapters hereinafter specified, and for those limited purposes only.

<u>NAME</u>	<u>TO ENFORCE</u>
Linda Lange	Appendix J (Zoning Ordinance) Chapter 44 (Trailer and Public Camps) Chapter 61 (Nuisance Code)

SECTION 2.

The individual appointed special officer pursuant to Section 1 shall, except in cases of emergency or unusual circumstances, secure the approval of the Planning Director or his authorized representative prior to issuing any misdemeanor citation.

SECTION 3.

Notwithstanding the appointment of the aforementioned individual as special police officer, such person shall not be considered safety personnel for purposes of the Sacramento City Employees' Retirement System.

SECTION 4.

Nothing herein shall be read to limit the power or authority of any duly appointed law enforcement officer of the City to enforce those chapters of the City Code heretofore set forth.
