RESOLUTION GIVING ASSISTANT CITY MANAGER  
FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT RESPONSIBILITY  
FOR TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, THE  
REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AND THE HOUSING  
AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

WHEREAS, The City of Sacramento and the Housing and Redevelopment  
Agency are currently working with other governmental agencies,  
including the Federal Government, State of California, Sacramento  
Regional Area Planning Commission, and Sacramento Regional Transit  
District on various transportation projects with community wide  
interest, and

WHEREAS, a number of these projects, particularly those involving  
Federal funding, require great speed, efficiency and coordination  
in processing, and

WHEREAS, there is a need for the City Council and the Housing  
and Redevelopment Agency to designate a lead staff person to  
administer and coordinate all of the pending and future transportation  
projects,

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council, with the consent of the City  
Manager, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento and  
the Housing Authority of the City of Sacramento hereby appoint  
and grant to the Assistant City Manager for Community Development  
full authority and responsibility for the administration, planning,  
processing, coordination, monitoring, evaluation and review of  
the I-80 Corridor Project, the Folsom Corridor Project, the Intermodal  
Transportation Center, the Sacramento Regional Transit District  
Development Plans and all other transportation programs involving  
the City of Sacramento, Redevelopment Agency and Housing Authority.
