SUBJECT: Purchase of One (1) Each Rescue Utility Light Tower Truck

SUMMARY

The Fleet Management Division has a requirement for the purchase of one (1) each rescue utility light tower truck which would ultimately be used by the City Fire Department. Since there is only one known source that manufactures this type of vehicle and that vendor currently has available a demonstrator model at a reduced cost (a savings of \$7,295), it is recommended that, in the best interests of the City, the City Council suspend formal competitive bidding for this requirement and authorize the City Manager to execute the necessary contract with Super Vacuum Manufacturing Company, Incorporated at a total cost of \$75,182.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City Council approved a similar recommendation on October 11, 1977 (Resolution #77-643) and authorized the purchase of one (1) each demonstrator model rescue utility light tower truck from Super Vacuum Manufacturing Company, Incorporated. On December 4, 1979, the City Council accepted a proposal from this same vendor (Bid Number 232) for a new rescue utility light tower truck in the amount of \$68,317 (Note: Only one proposal was received).

FINANCIAL DATA

The total cost for this vehicle is \$75,182. The source of funding for this purchase is from the Hazardous Material Mutual Aid Response Agreement with the County of Sacramento (Agreement #82-066, Resolution #82-882 dated December 14, 1982).

RECOMMENDATION

It is therefore recommended that, in the best interests of the City, the City Council adopt a resolution suspending formal competitive bidding for
