**SUMMARY**

The work on the Street Lighting Upgrade for Folsom Boulevard and Power Inn Road project was completed on January 2, 1992 at a cost of \$20,419.75 and project acceptance is recommended.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Accept the project;
2. Authorize the filing of the Notice of Completion and Acceptance of Work with the County Recorder; and
3. Authorize final payment.

**BACKGROUND**

M & M Electric Inc. of Sacramento has completed Project No. SG91, Council Contract No. 91-067, dated October 23, 1991. This project provided for the modification of the existing traffic signal system at the intersection of Folsom Boulevard and East Bicentennial Circle. Additional street lighting was installed along Folsom Boulevard and Power Inn Road. This project will provide enhanced pedestrian access between the existing Light Rail station at Power Inn Road and the new County Traffic and Small Claims Court on Bicentennial Circle.


