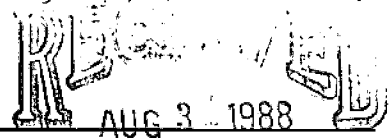

SUBJECT: Construction of a Running Track at Curtis Park (PN:LD66) - Project Approval and Bid Advertisement

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will construct a decomposed granite running track around the perimeter of Curtis Park on an existing dirt trail worn in by the Curtis Park runners.

A Categorical Exemption for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on May 8, 1987. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$78,000.

FINANCIAL

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$96,000. The current budget is \$112,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Capital Grants Fund (248) from the 1986 State Park Bond Act. The funds available for this project amount to \$111,000 as of August 18, 1988.

A non-refundable fee of \$15 will be charged for each set of plans and specifications to cover reproduction costs.


RECOMMENDATION
