SUBJECT: Pedestrian Walkway on 63rd Street (PN:TC11) - Project Approval And Bid Advertisement

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will reconstruct the existing pedestrian walkway on 63rd Street between Elder Creek Road and Lemon Hill Avenue and rehabilitate the existing pedestrian bridge over Morrison Creek. The existing walkway and bridge are both in an advanced state of deterioration and this project will provide greater safety for the children walking to Will C. Wood Middle School.

A Categorical Exemption for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on January 8, 1988. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$97,000.

FINANCIAL

Additional funds may be needed for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$130,000. The current budget is \$110,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Major Street Construction Funds. The final budgetary recommendation will be made following receipt of bids.

A non-refundable fee of \$20.00 will be charged for each set of plans and specifications to cover reproduction costs.

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RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for this project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on February 16, 1988.
