SUBJECT: TRAFFIC SIGNALS AND INTERCONNECT FOR GARDEN
HIGHWAY AND TRUXEL ROAD (PN:SG21) - PROJECT
APPROVAL AND BID ADVERTISEMENT

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will install traffic signals at the intersection of Garden Highway and Truxel Road. Improvements will include pedestrian operated walk lights and additional street lighting on Garden Highway. The new signals will be interconnected with existing signals at Garden Highway and the Interstate 5 ON/OFF ramps, Garden Highway and Natomas Park Drive and at Truxel Road and West El Camino Avenue.

It is contemplated that the project bid will be awarded on July 23, 1991. The project is located on the Sacramento River levee and it is necessary for all underground work to be completed prior to November 1, 1991 as required by the State Department of Water Resources.

A Categorical Exemption for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on March 6, 1991. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$150,300.

FINANCIAL DATA

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$201,500. The current budget is \$204,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from the South Natomas Community Improvement funds (795). The funds available for this project amount to \$203,500, as of June 11, 1991.

Plans and specifications will be sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry of Northern California.


RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for this project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on July 16, 1991.



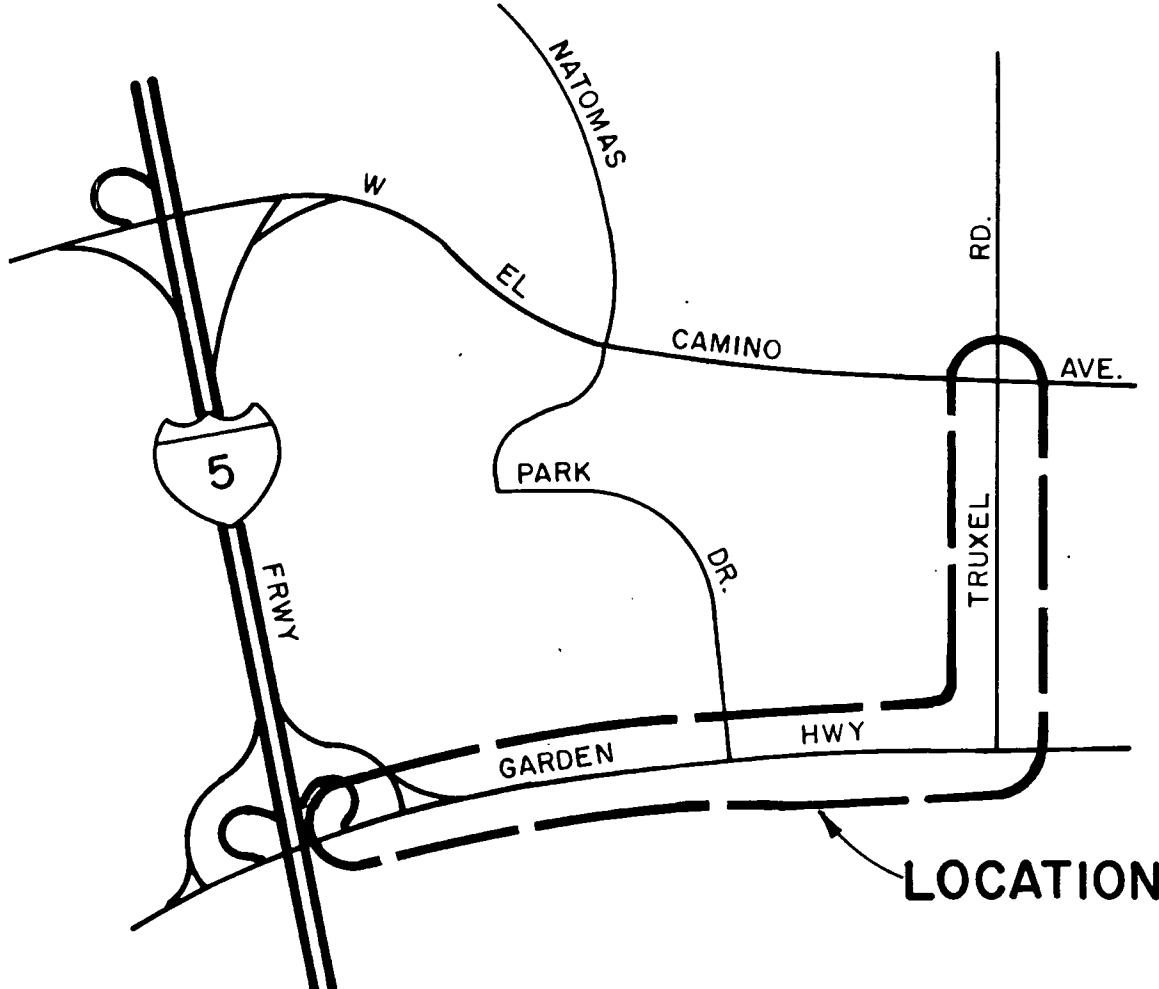
