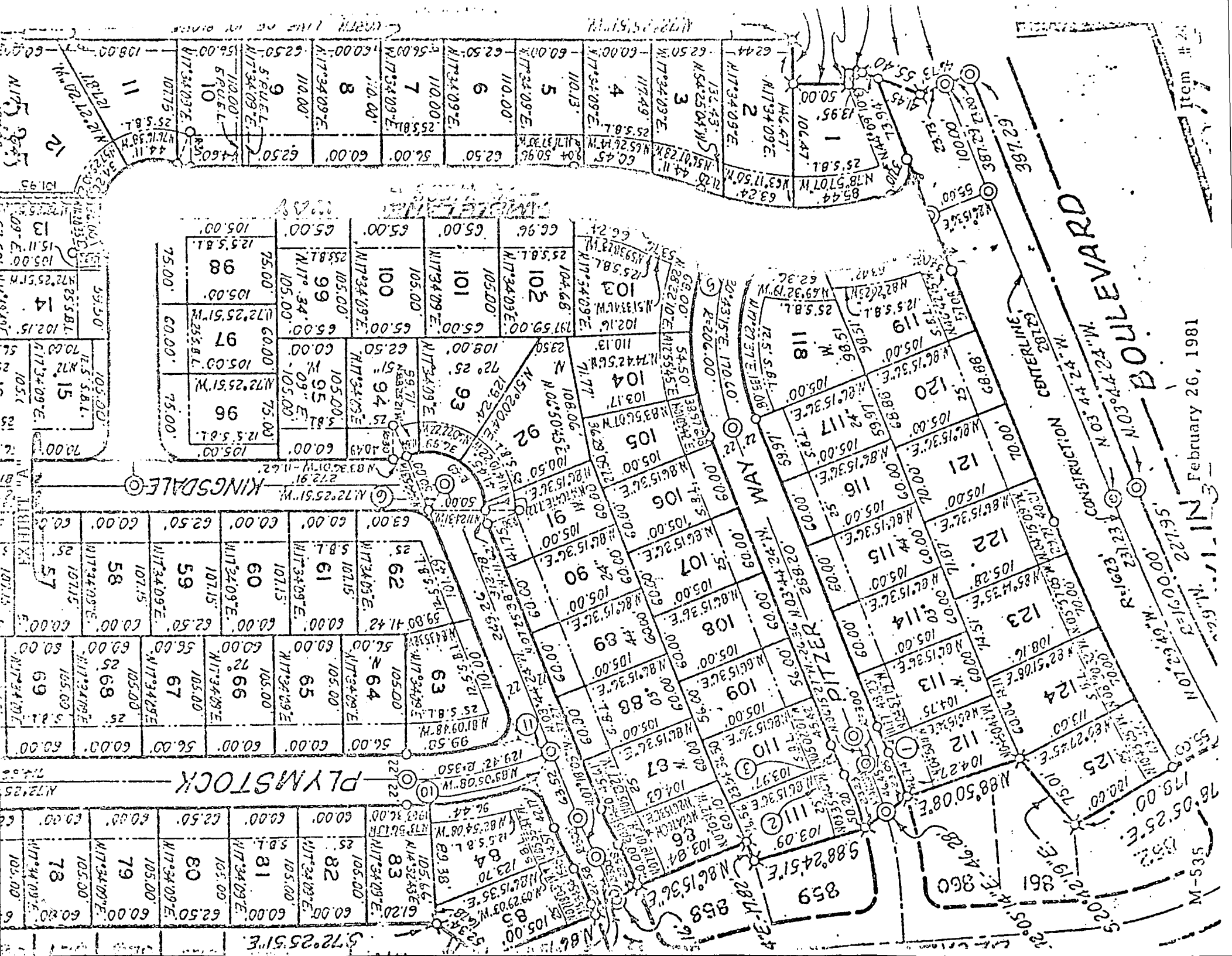


BACKGROUND INFORMATION
