



**RESOLUTION GRANTING REVOCABLE
ENCROACHMENT PERMIT TO GTEL**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That a Revocable Encroachment Permit be granted to GTEL, 601 Sequoia Pacific, Sacramento, CA 95814 for the purpose of updating CALNET System at various locations between L Street and P Street, and 7th Street and 13th Street.

This encroachment is described as follows:

From the intersection of L Street and 10th Street south on 10th Street 280 feet to the Point of beginning; thence south on 10th Street to the intersection of the N-O Alley; thence east 160 feet on the N-O Alley.

Beginning at the intersection of 10th Street and N Street east to the intersection of N Street and 12th Street; thence south on 12 Street to the intersection of 12th and P Street; thence west on P Street to the intersection of P Street and 11th Street; thence north on 11th Street to the intersection of 11th Street and the O-P Alley; thence west on the O-P Alley 220 feet.

Beginning at the intersection of the O-P Alley and 11th Street north on 11 Street to the intersection of 11th Street and O Street.

Beginning at the intersection of 12th Street and the N-O Street Alley east on the N-O Street Alley 275 feet.

Beginning at the intersection of 8th Street and the L-Capitol Mall Alley west on the L-Capitol Mall Alley 223 feet.

Beginning at the intersection of 8th Street and the L-Capitol Mall Alley east on the L-Capitol Alley 178 feet.

Beginning at the intersection of 8th Street and the N-O Alley east on the N-O Alley 175 feet.

From the intersection of Capitol Mall and 8th Street east along the centerline of Capitol Mall 275 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence south 70 feet.
