SUBJECT: REPLACEMENT SIX (6) REAR LOADING REFUSE TRUCKS

SUMMARY

The proposed FY 1988-89 Fleet Management Replacement Budget request provides for the replacement of six (6) rear loading refuse trucks for the Solid Waste Division, Street Cleaning Section. This report requests authorization for the purchase of six (6) new rear loading refuse trucks from F. B. Hart Co. under the same terms and conditions as a prior contract, for a total purchase price of \$515,441. However, this purchase will not be implemented until the FY 1988-89 Fleet Management Replacement Budget is approved by Council.

BACKGROUND

The FY 1988-89 Fleet Management Replacement Budget has six (6) rear loading refuse trucks scheduled to be replaced.

Four (4) new rear loading refuse trucks were recently delivered from Bid No. 1102 by the F. B. Hart Co. These units have proven to be quite acceptable and can legally carry a greater payload than the existing units. The F. B. Hart Co. has offered to the City, six (6) identical units at the same price per unit as those of the previous contract. Additionally, they could be delivered to the City and in service prior to the start of leaf season in October.

Early ordering of the trucks will allow Fleet Management to remove older, higher maintenance and less efficient trucks from the Fleet prior to the peak seasonal demand.


FINANCIAL DATA

The total cost for this requirement is \$515,441. \$558,000 has been budgeted in the proposed FY 1988-89 Fleet Management Replacement Budget for these units. This purchase will not be implemented until the FY 1988-89 Fleet Management Replacement Budget is approved by Council.


RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council, by passage of the attached resolution, authorize the City Manager to execute the necessary contract with F. B. Hart Co. for six (6) rear loading refuse trucks in an amount not to exceed \$515,441 after approval of the FY 1988-89 Budget.

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

RESOLUTION SUSPENDING FORMAL COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF SIX (6) REAR LOADING REFUSE TRUCKS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY CONTRACT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, TWO-THIRDS (2/3) OF ALL MEMBERS VOTING IN FAVOR THEREOF:

That pursuant to section 57.401(c) of the Sacramento City Code, it is hereby determined to be in the best interests of the City to suspend formal competitive bidding for the purchase of six (6) rear loading refuse trucks and that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the necessary contract with the F. B. Hart Co., 1441 Richards Blvd., Sacramento, CA 95814, in an amount not to exceed \$515,441.
