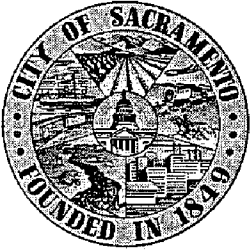

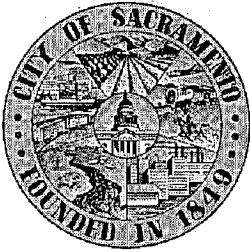



From my perspective I think these are the answers:

1. This is still correct but we are using a "To Be Delivered Later" form and process that Dawn B. can send to you.
2. I believe the change will make this an informational report. The establishment of a new fee requires a Public Hearing and notice so I think that official hearing will be in January with adoption and the 14th will be an informational item which can stay as a staff report as currently listed.
3. Because the agenda has not been printed and the report has not been released I believe it is best to deliver the report late if needed but in the new format vs. using the old report for the agenda and changing it out later.
4. In the past if the report could be delivered prior to noon on Friday it could be inserted, I believe this has changed. Now, I believe anything not available when the item is sent to print and put on the intranet is part of a supplemental agenda and requires purple sheeting on the To Be Delivered document (which Dawn B. can provide to you).

Dawn, if any of this is incorrect can you please reply to all so both Pete and I know what we need to do.
