## **SUMMARY**

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

## BACKGROUND

On September 25, 1985, the City Council approved plans and specifications for this project and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on October 15, 1985. Bids received are as follows:

> Malott and Peterson-Grundy A and B Asphalt Sealing Co.

\$ 16,781.00 17,648,00

The estimated completion date for the project is January 1, 1986.

## FINANCIAL

The City Council has approved \$18,000 in the Parks and Community Services budget from the General Fund for this project. The total amount currently available is \$17,000. It is proposed that \$2,800 in General Funds be transferred from the Miscellaneous Tennis Court Resurfacing Project (CC:2120). The Fund Transfer was considered by the Budget and Finance Committee during their meeting of November 6, 1985 with a staff recommendation for approval of the attached Resolution.

RESOLUTION AMENDING FY 1985-86 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BUDGET FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND COMMUNITY SERVICES FOR THE TENNIS COURT RESURFACING PROJECTS

#### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

- 1. That the bids for resurfacing tennis courts at four park sites were over the budget amount.
- 2. That the City FY 1985-86 Capital Improvement budget for the Department of Parks and Community Services is hereby amended for:
  - a. Transferring \$2,800 from the Hall/Curtis/Cabrillo (miscellaneous) tennis court resurfacing C.I.P. No. 101-4521-2120 to the McKinley Park tennis court resurfacing C.I.P. No. 101-4521-2119.
  - b. Adding \$10,000 to the Miscellaneous Tennis Courts Resurfacing Project No. 101-4521-2120 from the Quimby Act Reserve fund No. 7-10-7012-0000-4599.
