WHEREAS, the purpose of National Arts Week is to focus public attention on the arts and creativity in the community resulting in a nationwide celebration of the cultural richness of creativity of the arts; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Anne Rudin, Mayor of the City of Sacramento, do hereby proclaim September 23 - 29, 1990 as NATIONAL ARTS WEEK '90 in this City in the celebration of the Arts.
