RESOLUTION NO. 85-351

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE TOM KENNY ANNUAL LABOR DAY PICNIC & FESTIVAL

WHEREAS, "Labor Day" is the nationally recognized holiday for all working men and women in the U.S.; and,

WHEREAS, Labor Day offers a prime opportunity to acknowledge organized labor and working people's contribution to the Sacramento community; and,

WHEREAS, Thomas P. Kenny was an active leader of organized labor and served the Sacramento community in many activities; and,

WHEREAS, Thomas P. Kenny served as the Executive Secretary of the Sacramento Central Labor Council, AFL-CIO from 1971 to 1984, when his untimely death occurred; and,

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Central Labor Council, AFL-CIO and various other labor organizations in the Sacramento, Yolo, Amador, Placer and El Dorado Counties have proclaimed "Labor Day" on September 2, 1985, as the official day for all working men and women to join together to celebrate their holiday at the Tom Kenny Annual Labor Day Picnic and Festival;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and members of the Council of the City of Sacramento, that they recognize and support the "Second Annual Tom Kenny Labor Day Picnic and Festival" as organized labor's official celebration in Sacramento.
